TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entrants may cash only once with the same partner.
2. All team captains must check in lineups at least 30 minutes before bowling time for team.
3. Highest USBC sanctioned average of the previous season based on 12 games or more must be used. (Subject to rule 6)
4. When previous season's average are used and at the time of entry and entrant has a current season average for 12 or more games which is 10 or more pins above the previous season's average, current season's average must be used.
5. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 months must report: Actual scores, position, amount won for possible rerating.
6. Any bowler who reports a lower average than required or fails to report a prize of \$600.00 or more won in the previous 12 months, shall forfeit all tournament entry fees and prize winnings. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his or her average. Read rule 319-A or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher.
7. Averages established in the summer will not be acceptable, summer leagues are defined as leagues which start their schedule after March 15th for the summer season only.
8. A bowler who has no 12 game average for the previous season must use the highest current season average as of March 1st, 2023(minimum 12 games), if no average, 200 will be used for men, 175 for women.
9. Handicap will be 100%, using scratch basis of 220.
10. Maximum handicap is unlimited, to be allowed by any player.
11. Report all substitutions to tournament manager at least 30 minutes before squad time.
12. Prize Ratio- there shall be at least one prize for each 10 entries, all USBC rules apply.
13. In case of protest, call the Supervisor or Tournament Manager at once.
14. A complete prize list will be posted at the bowling establishment.
15. Make all money payable to Gowanda Volunteer Fire Company, Inc.
16. Prize fees returned 100%. All money must accompany entry.
17. ALL AVERAGES MUST BE ATTESTED BY THE LEAGUES SECRETARY.
18. It's the bowler's responsibility to submit adjusted averages per USBC Rule 319-A
19. Unmarried, Grade and High School students who have not attained the age of 18, must have written consent of their parents or guardian to bowl for cash prizes. Parental consent forms will be available at the alleys of from the committee and must be received at least one week prior to participation in the tournament unless the student is accompanied by his or her parent or legal guardian in which case the parental consent form may be filled out up to the time the student starts to bowl. USBC Rule 13.
20. Each entrant must produce his or her individual USBC membership card or pay association dues of \$21.00. USBC Rule 310-B
21. Only one PBA member per team.
